ORDER

On amendments to Order No. 331 "On measures aimed at the prevention of the spread of the new coronavirus infection COVID-19 in the dormitories of Moscow Aviation Institute" dated July 9, 2021

In accordance with clauses 5, 8, 10 of part 1, part 2, part 4 of article 41 of the Federal Law of December 29, 2012 No. 273-FZ "On Education in the Russian Federation", taking into account Ordinance of the Mayor of Moscow dated August 13, 2021 No. 51-YM "On amendments to Ordinance of the Mayor of Moscow dated June 8, 2020 No. 68-YM", in addition to the Regulations on the Campus of Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Moscow Aviation Institute (National Research University)", approved by Order of MAI dated August 17, 2018 No. 697 and the Internal Regulations on the Campus of Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of Higher Education "Moscow Aviation Institute (National Research University)", approved by Order of MAI dated August 17, 2018 No. 698, in connection with epidemiological situation easing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Clause 1.1. of Order dated July 9, 2021 No. 331 "On measures aimed at the prevention of the spread of the new coronavirus infection COVID-19 in the dormitories of Moscow Aviation Institute" (hereinafter - the Order) shall be amended as follows: "Students in need of living quarters, as well as students living in the dormitory, after a period of their temporary absence from the dormitory (more than one day) may check in after a medical examination at MAI Health Care Center upon the provision of the following document to the therapist of MAI Health Care Center:

- Negative results of laboratory tests for SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus by PCR method (the results are valid for 72 hours), or

- A document confirming vaccination against the new coronavirus infection COVID-19 with a single-component vaccine or the second component of a two-component vaccine that passed the state registration in the Russian Federation, or

- A document confirming the disease caused by the new coronavirus infection (COVID-19) over the past 6 months and a document containing information on the presence of antibodies (IgG, to S-protein) to the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus (the results are valid for 6 months).

2. Clause 3 of the Order shall be amended as follows: "Establish that the students who submitted the following documents to the therapist of the Health Care Center are exempt from the restrictions provided for by this Order:

- A document confirming vaccination against the new coronavirus infection COVID-19 with a single-component vaccine or the second component of a two-component vaccine that passed the state registration in the Russian Federation, or

- A document confirming the disease caused by the new coronavirus infection (COVID-19) over the past 6 months and a document containing information on the presence of antibodies (IgG, to S-protein) to the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus (the results are valid for 6 months)".

3. Clauses 1.2., 1.3., 2 of the Order shall be no longer in force.

4. I shall personally supervise the implementation hereof.
